Drunkenness - Excessive drinking to the degree the will is impaired by the loss of personal control.

Carousing - Unrestrained revelry; mob orgy.

Lying - The opposite of truthfulness. Justifying behavior that would embarrass or convict. Satan is the author, the father of all lies.

Wrath (orge) - Long-lived anger; chronic anger. An angry person. The threshold of bitterness.

Thievery - Stealing or taking what does not belong to you.

Grieving the Spirit - Doing that which the Bible forbids. Causing grief to the Spirit by what one thinks and does. Behavior that disregards the promptings of the Holy Spirit.

Quenching the Spirit - Putting out the fire and zeal of the Holy Spirit. Allowing pride and position to overrule the moving of the Spirit of God.

Bitterness - Long-standing resentment; unresolved anger; refusing reconciliation.

Clamor - Out-shouting someone else; loud talking; drowning out the opinions of others with loud and/or boisterous speech.

Slander - Finding fault with others and spreading it throughout the church.

Malice - A vicious character; bad in quality.

Evil - The opposite of justice. Robbing God and man of his due.

Villainy - Destructive evil. Attempting to make others as bad as yourself. (This characteristic absolutely defines Satan.)

Lust (possessiveness) - Never fulfilled, always wanting more. The desire that knows no law. Desiring things one has no right to.

Viciousness - Essential badness; complete degeneracy. Hurting others simply for the sake of it.

Disobedience - Obstinate, stubborn, refusal to obey.

Wrong Desires - Passionate desire for forbidden pleasure. Desires that go beyond reason.
