Flattering Tongue: Psalm 5:9 For there is no faithfulness in their mouth; Their inward part is destruction; Their throat is an open tomb.

Proud Tongue: Psalm 12:3-4 & 73:9: May the Lord cut off all flattering lips, and the tongue that speaks proud things: Who has said, "With our tongue we will prevail; Our lips are our own: Who is lord over us?" 73:9: They set their mouth against the heavens, and their tongue walk through the earth.

Lying tongue: Psalm 109:2: For the couth of the wicked and the mouth of the deceitful have opened against me; they have spoken against me with a lying tongue. Proverbs 6:16-19: These six things the Lord hates, yes, seven are an abomination to Him. A proud lock, a lying tongue, hands that shed innocent blood, a heart that devises wicked plans, feet that are swift in running to evil, a false witness who speaks lies, and one who sows discord among brethren.

Deceitful tongue Psalm 120:2: Deliver me soul, O lord, from lying lips and from a deceitful tongue.

Healing tongue: Proverbs 12:18: There is one that speaks like the piercings of a sword, but the tongue of the wise promotes health.

Destructive tongue: Proverbs 17:4: An evildoer gives heed to false lips; a liar listens eagerly to a spiteful tongue.

Mischievous/wicked tongue: Psalm 10:7: His mouth is full of cursing and deceit and oppression; under his tongue is trouble and iniquity.

Soft tongue: Proverbs 25:15: By long forbearance ruler is persuaded; and a gentle tongue breaks a bone.

Backbiting tongue: Proverbs 25:23: The north wind brings forth rain, and a backbiting tongue an angry countenance.
