1.	Redeemer: Psalm 19:14; Isaiah 63:16; Jeremiah 50:34 My Father cared enough to redeem me out of the authority of darkness. He redeemed me from the power of sin and from the hold of Satan, and He put me into His kingdom.
2.	Merciful: 2 Samuel 24:14; Psalm 86:15; Ephesians 2:4 My Father is always merciful to me, regardless of my circumstances. In the dark storms of self-reproach and condemnation, He is always merciful.
3.	Forgiving: Psalm 86:5; 103:10-12; Hebrews 10:17 He has forgiven me completely and totally for all my sins and transgressions, past, present and future. He forgives, He forgets – He wipes the slate of my heart clean.
4.	Compassionate: Psalm 103:8,13; 111:4; Matthew 9:36 My Father's heart is full of compassion for me for He has shared intimately all my pain and hurt and sorrows. Through His compassion, He affirms and supports me.
5.	Gentle: Psalm 18:35; Matthew 11:29; 21:5 He is a gentle Person. He deals with me so gently. My Father's gentleness permeates my being, making me a gentle person.
6.	Beautiful: Psalm 27:4; 96:6 He is the lily of the valley, the bright and morning star, the fairest of ten thousand. My Father is a beautiful Person, and He believes me to be a beautiful person.
7.	Cleanses: Isaiah 1:18; Acts 15:9; 1 John 1:9 The blood of Christ cleanses me from all unrighteousness. No matter the defilement, my Father cleanses, moment by moment.
8.	Holy: Psalm 99:3,5,9; 108:7 The beauty of holiness shrouds my Father. He is absolutely holy, thus He makes me holy.
9.	Pardons: Psalm 103:3; Romans 8:1; Hebrews 10:17 He freely pardons me – all my sins, all my transgressions; even the defilement is pardoned. I am free. The Father took me as His precious child and sacrificed His Son to pardon me.
10.	Reasonable: Isaiah 1:18; 1 Corinthians 10:13 To think that my Father would reason with me. How important that makes me feel. He never demands more than I am able to really give. In every way, He is so very reasonable.
